



KEVIN KER is best known as the songwriter and front-man for Future History and Man Made Forest, as well as the founder and president of Epidemic Music Group. He gained international recognition for organizing and producing the official Guinness World Record for the “Longest Concert by Multiple Artists” in March of 2017. The 437-hour long concert raised \$100,000 for 17 local charities and garnered international media attention. A proponent of collaborative musical community, Kevin hosts four weekly open mics (The 8-year old Markham Village Open Mic at The Duchess in Markham, the 5-year old Stouffville Open Stage, the 3-year old Unionville Open Stage at Jake’s Pub and Grille in Unionville and the brand-new Sweet Sounds of the Old

Firehall: A Family Open Mic).

Kevin Ker is also responsible for the development and curation of multiple music festivals and events, including: The Markham Village Music Festival, Taste of Stouffville, Wintersong Music Festival, The Markham Craft Beer and Wine Festival, Music on Main, Markham Rib Fest, Springsong, The Unionville Festival and many more. As a record producer, Kevin has worked with such artists as; Adam Gontier (Three Days Grace), Human Kebab (USS), Rich Beddoe (Finger 11), The Beresfords, Kevin Foster and Sarah Fazackerley (Mayfly’s Landing).
